

Dear BUSD Families,

We are excited to announce that starting **Monday, September 14th**, we will begin our Meal Delivery service BUSD EATS for all our *Community Eligibility Provision* (CEP) schools! Please note that **all** students at these schools are eligible for free meals as stated on the household letter. On your scheduled delivery date your child/ren will receive 5 days of Heat and Serve meals with contactless meal drop offs on your doorstep; no need to be home. Meals will start being delivered between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. The meals will count for 5 weekdays until the next scheduled delivery date (Note: this does not include Saturday and Sunday). Please follow the schedule below to see when you can expect your student's contactless meal drop off.

**Site Scheduled Delivery Dates**

***\*For September 14th-16th only:*** *If you are scheduled to have meals delivered on Tuesday, Sept. 15th or Wednesday, Sept. 16th, please continue to pick up your 1-day meals from your school sites until your delivery date. Please note that starting September 21, 2020 through the remainder of distance learning you will no longer need to come to the school to pick up meals and the days below will be your delivery day.*
