Written Component (Questions are on the Google Form Application):

Be prepared to respond to the following questions on the Google Form:

- What are your academic goals for middle school?
- In 3-5 sentences, explain what makes you a strong candidate for the AVID Elective.
- Please list your any main extracurricular, community, and family activities or hobbies in the order of their interest to you. Include specific events and/or major accomplishments, such as musical instruments played and/or participation in sports teams, etc.
- Do you enjoy school? If yes, describe what you like the most about school. If no, describe what would make school better.
- What do you think are the top 3 most important characteristics of a successful student?

Interview Component Directions/Requirements:

- There will be an in person group interview with AVID Teachers as a final part of the application process.
- Be prepared to discuss all questions that were on the written component of the AVID application.
- The interviews will be held during PRIDE Time on the week of March 21-25
