

SCHOOL QUARANTINE FLOW CHART

Are you a close contact?*

no

You do not need to quarantine

yes

Are you (1) recently recovered from COVID-19 within the last 90 days OR (2) a student who is fully vaccinated OR (3) a staff who is up to date on COVID-19 vaccinations?

no

You must quarantine and may end your quarantine after either:

yes

Are you asymptomatic?

no

You must follow isolation guidance; see school isolation flow chart

yes

Have you had COVID-19 in the past 90 days?

yes

You do not need to quarantine or test

no

You do not need to quarantine but you must test on or close to Day* 5 in order to remain in school.

**Day 0 is the last date of exposure. Day 1 is the first day after the last date of exposure.*

- Ten (10) full days from your last known contact. Activities may resume on Day* 11.

OR

- Five (5) full days from your last known contact if you have a negative viral test collected on or close to Day 5. Activities may resume as early as Day 6.

If you are a student without symptoms with a mask-on-mask exposure at school, you may remain in school if you test negative twice weekly: once as soon as possible after exposure and once again on or close to Day 5. If you are a staff without symptoms, you may remain in school if you test negative between Day 3-5.

Students or staff who remain in school during their quarantine period must quarantine at home when not at school.

**Day 0 is the last date of exposure. Day 1 is the first full day after the last date of exposure.*
