Kindergarten Enrollment 2019-2020

The Bellflower Unified School District provides a variety of programs for incoming Kindergarten students. The various programs provide options for parents to enroll their children in a program that best meets their needs. Kindergarten enrollment begins on Tuesday, February 19, 2019.

The following programs are available at schools throughout the District.

- **Kindergarten (Available at ALL BUSD schools)**
For students turning 5 on or before September 1, 2019.
- **Transitional Kindergarten (Available at Stephen Foster, Washington, Ernie Pyle, Esther Lindstrom, subject to change based on enrollment.)**
The first year of a two year Kindergarten program. For students turning 5 between September 2, 2019 through December 2, 2019.
- **Jump Start Kindergarten (Available at Craig Williams Elementary School)**
Jump Start Kindergarten provides students a semester of opportunities to develop fundamental skills in language arts and mathematics that will lay the foundation for Kindergarten and future academic success. For students turning 5 between December 3, 2019 through February 4, 2020. Enrollment for this program will take place at a later date.
- **Dual Immersion (Available at the Intensive Learning Center & Washington Elementary)**
A program designed for students to develop bilingual/biliterate skills in English and Spanish while attaining grade level and 21st century skills. For students turning 5 on or before September 1, 2019. For further information, contact the Educational Services Office at (562) 866-9011 ext. 2302.
- **Home Education Independent Study Academy (Available at Las Flores Educational Center)**
This program offers families the option to partially or fully home school their child in grades TK-12. For further information, please contact the Home Education Independent Study Academy at (562) 804-6565.

Elementary registration continues through June 19, 2019. Offices will re-open for registration on or about August 8, 2019. *Registration Hours: 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. daily.*

The following items must be presented at the time of enrollment:

- California Driver's License or California ID with current address
- 2 recent utility bills (gas, electric, water)
- Child's original birth certificate and immunization records
